The cast and crew from The Lord of the Rings recently learned of the death of his colleague Andrew Jack, the show's dialect coach, who died in April at the age of 76 from complications from COVID-19. And this is not Gad's first rodeo. He previously joined the cast of two hit 1985 films, Goonies and Back to the Future. Earlier this week, they brought Tom Hanks, Daryl Hannah, Eugene Levy and Ron Howard together to discuss their 1984 classic Splash. In each episode, Gad raises money for a charity called COVID-19. Previous organisations included project HOPE (Global Health and Humanitarian Aid Programme) DigDeep (working to ensure that every American has access to water and sanitation) and the Center for Disaster Philanthropy (supporting those most affected by the COVID-19 pandemic). Reunited Apart: The Lord of the Rings will premiere on Sunday, May 31 at 9:00 AM BST on Gad's YouTube channel.
